

Preregistration Guide for First Semester 2020-2021 & 2020 Summer Session Registration

Preregistration Activities: April 13-April 21

- Complete your eReservation in StudentCentral under the Register menu option.
- Ensure your financial account balance is up-to-date to avoid any delays. Pay your account or contact a <u>financial aid counselor</u> to discuss your options.
- Build your trial class schedule.
- Address any critical validations or get help from your advisor to do this.
- Auditions for Music Lessons & Instrumental Groups: Auditions will be held in the fall during registration at the start of the semester. Students who change to a music major or add a music minor should contact the division of music <u>here</u> concerning auditions.
- Placement Tests: If you need to take a placement test, please do so before you contact your advisor. You can find more information about placements tests <u>here</u>.
- Contact your advisor for permission to register. Your advisor will change your advising status to advised.
- Contact your work manager to discuss your work schedule.

First Semester Preregistration Period: April 21- May 5

- Submit your trial schedule.
- Look for an email that tells you when your registration window opens. Registration times open by seniority.

First Semester Preregistration – Reopens & Closes: Aug. 1-19

First Semester Check-in & Registration Completion

- Check-in: Monday, Aug. 24 by 5 p.m.
 - Residence Hall Students: Check-in at your residence halls.
 - Day Students: Check-in at the Student Development & Discipleship Office or Welcome Center.
- Once checked in, complete your First Semester registration by accepting your preregistered class schedule in StudentCentral under the Register menu option.

Summer Registration begins March 16 until:

May 19 for the <u>Summer Session</u> (e.g., courses for internships, mission teams, studies aboard, etc.) the Friday before course start date if you are taking the class online (see chart below).
<u>Online Class</u> registration is through your StudentCentral home page.
